Event Report

Event: Observance of Students' Week

Venue: Ranaghat College

Duration: 2nd January, 2023 – 7th January, 2023

Objective: It was intended for enlivening the spirit of students. The observance of Students' Week also aimed at promoting the extracurricular activities of students and offering them opportunity to show their talent by participating in various cultural and sporting events. It provided them a bit relief from rigorous academic routine too.

Description: As per the instruction of Government of West Bengal, Students' Week was observed in Ranaghat College from 2nd January to 7th January, 2023 with the active participation of students and members of teaching and non-teaching staff of college. Various programs namely career counseling program, health awareness program, cultural program and seminar related to the scope and progress of students were organized during Students' Week. In order to boost up the energy, enthusiasm and competitive attitude of students, matches of cricket, football and badminton were held too during this period.

The inaugural program was held on 2nd January, 2023 at 11.30 am as it was the opening day of Students' Week. The Principal, Dr. Arup Kumar Maiti, and the President of Governing Body of Ranaghat College, Dr. Jyoti Prakash Ghosh inaugurated the program in the presence of all members of Teaching and Nonteaching staff and mammoth gathering of students by lighting the lamp. The inaugural program was followed by a seminar on Library Orientation and thereafter a football match was held between the existing students and alumni of college. On the second day, a seminar on **Present Time and Student Community** was organized in the Seminar Hall of Jubilee Building of College from 11.30 which continued for one hour. Dr. Arunoday Mukherjee, Coordinator of IQAC, and some members of the teaching faculty of college namely Dr. Abarna Mukhopadhyay, Dr. Santanu Ger and Dr. HabiburRahaman focused on academic aspects as well as the necessity to develop sense of duty and values in the seminar. Besides the seminar, extempore speech and quiz contest were held that day and the day came to an end with the cricket match held between the teaching faculty and alumni of college. The program of the following day started with the awareness program on health and hygiene followed by the health check-up camp. A renowned physician named Dr. ParthaSarathi Ain delivered a very useful lecture regarding food habits and hygiene as a part of the program. The day witnessed recitation contest, a drawing contest on environment and Kabadi and Khokho matches for female students. In all kinds of contest, students participated with great enthusiasm and try their level best to perform everything properly. On the fourth day of the celebration of Students' Week, the parent-teacher meeting was held in every department with the active participation of guardians and the teaching faculty. Various suggestions came up from guardians in the meeting and teachers of

different departments put forth their views regarding the attendance and performance of students. The essay competition and badminton matches of female students were held afterwards and the performance of students was quite inspiring. The day came to a close with the dance competition held in the evening and both the audience and performers enjoyed it very much. The penultimate day of Students' Week Celebration witnessed Career Counseling Program, Sports Meet and music competition. The members of teaching faculty of college Dr. Abarna Mukhopadhyay, Dr. HabiburRahaman and some others drew the attention of students to various aspects and prospects of career and point out the ways the learner should adopt to meet the challenges of job market in future. Students displayed their brilliant performance in different events of Sports Meet and showed their competitive attitude to secure prizes. It was followed by musical performance of students in the evening. The closing ceremony of the observance of Students' Week was held on 7th January 2023. The dignitaries who adorned the stage during the closing ceremony included Controller of Examinations of University of Kalyani, Dr. Bimalendu Biswas, Chairman of Ranaghat Municipality, Sri KosaldevBandopadhyay, and the members of the Governing Body of Ranaghat College. The distribution of prizes among the successful performers of every event was made by the dignitaries. The attraction of the final day of Students' Week was the charismatic performance of N.C.C cadets. Another attraction of the closing ceremony was the cultural program in which both learners and members of teaching faculty participated and drew high praise from the spellbound audience.

Feedback: The feedback of students was more spontaneous and inspiring for college than what the authority had expected. Students enjoyed the observance of Students' Week extremely. They appreciated highly the student-friendly program organized in college.
